If the condition is true, then a certain set of instructions will be executed. Else (condition is false), then a different set of instructions will be executed.</p>
<p><i>What is the main difference between Wi-Fi and Bluetooth</i></p> <p>Wi-Fi can support multiple devices at once, while Bluetooth can only support a small number of devices.</p>	<p><i>What are the two main types of cables used in ethernet networks</i></p> <p>Copper cables and fiber optic cables.</p>	<p><i>What happens during the sampling process</i></p> <p>Answer: Sound is recorded in snippets at set intervals.</p>
